Who Are We?

Who are we, as we stand before the child Jesus? Who are we, as we stand before today's children? Are we like Mary and Joseph, who welcomed Jesus and cared for him with the love of a father and a mother? Or are like Herod, who wanted to eliminate him? Are we like the shepherds, who went in haste to kneel before him in worship and offer him their humble gifts? Or are we indifferent? Are we ready to be there for children, to "waste time" with them? Are we ready to listen to them, to care for them, to pray for them and with them? Or do we ignore them because we are too caught up in our own affairs? Pope Francis: Bethlehem, May 25, 2014, Most of us feel like we know ourselves better than anyone else. But then, sometimes, something happens, or we meet someone and it changes our ideas about who we are. This happened when Jesus was born. His birth changed the history of the world: he unsettled the whole world. That challenged many people in power and demands our attention today just as it did for the Magi and the shepherds. These men --- learned and foreign, humble and simple---didn't come to help out with the baby; they didn't come to fulfill any social obligations. They came in wonder.
