

CELEBRATING 200 Years

You are invited to a once in a life time occasion in **Mount Carmel Monastery**: the **200th Anniversary** of the celebration of the very first Mass there on the 20th July 1817. There was no public celebration held to mark the 50th, 100th or 150th

anniversaries.....they all passed almost unnoticed. This must not be allowed to happen for the 200th!! Please come and show the Carmelites by your presence the love and esteem in which they are held. Bring a friend! But above all else, don't leave it to everyone else to turn up: come yourself. The Carmelites will see how many friends they have by your presence.

At 7.30 p.m on Thursday 20th July in the grounds of Mount Carmel Monastery an open air Mass will be celebrated. This is 200 years to the day of the very first Mass in Mount Carmel on 20th July 1817. Mass has been celebrated every single day for 200 years of this same place. It is truly "holy ground".

There will be seating for a couple of hundred which will be largely reserved for the elderly and infirm.

There will be plenty of standing room for everyone else. You are asked to plan as close to 7 as possible so that everyone can in place by 7.15 p.m. A cup of tea will be available at the end. Details of parking arrangements will be announced later.

Today's Readings.

The followers of Christ must have courage at all times. Christ has promised support in time of trial. Death and imprisonment for Christ are realities for many Christians. The erosion of faith and the dechristianising of values can also be frightening. But Jesus says to all 'Be not afraid.'

First Reading Romans 5:12-15

As we observe what is happening in the world around us, it is easy to feel insignificant and without purpose. Jesus reminds us that our value in intrinsic, our worth cannot be compromised. They are infinitely loved by God too.
