The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ Corpus Christi



The Deep End • Corpus Christi

On this feast of Corpus Christi we celebrate the gift of the Eucharist. It was one of the last actions of Jesus to give us this nourishment for our life journey, to remember him and to help us to live out his teachings in our daily lives.

As Christ's followers we are all called to change from within so that we can be part of the building of a kingdom of love, justice and peace in this world, so that we ourselves are transformed in some way. The Eucharist, as Pope Francis says, 'is not a prize for the perfect but a powerful medicine and nourishment for the weak'. It is a call for all of us to grow and to share with one another Christ's message of love and peace. The Eucharist sustains us on this Christian path and brings us together as sisters and brothers travelling together on this journey of faith. We should leave this table changed by the encounter, a little lighter, a little more hopeful and joyful, a little stronger.

In a movie I saw recently there was a line which said 'the world will only change as we change'. The Eucharist invites us to this transformation. Because 'in the Eucharist, God comes to us not from above, but from within. In the Eucharist the whole cosmos gives thanks to God... it is itself an act of cosmic love... The Eucharist joins heaven and earth; it embraces and penetrates all creation' (Pope Francis, *Laudato Si'*).

TODAYS READINGS

'From this feast of Corpus Christi have originated many practices of eucharistic devotion that, under the inspiration of divine grace, have increased from day to day and that the Catholic Church uses eagerly to show ever greater homage to Christ, to thank him for so great a gift and to implore his mercy'. (Pope Paul VI)

First Reading

Exodus 24:13-8

Around 1240 BC a nomadic group of slaves pursued by an Egyptian army detachment is saved by God through an extraordinary intervention. Moses, a prophet, led the fugitives and interpreted this event for them: Yahweh, the only true God, had chosen them to be God's people. Moses and his followers were to remain a long time in the oasis of Sinai, and it was there that Moses would give them Yahweh's law recounted in today's first reading. At the foot of Mount Sinai the Covenant with God which would govern the life of Israel was signed and sealed with the blood of animals.

Second Reading

Hebrews 9:11-15

This reading describes how Christ has established a new covenant. Like the old covenant it too was sealed with blood but in this case it was not the blood of animals but his own blood. By the sacrificial death of Christ God has entered into a new and eternal intimate relationship with God's people.

Gospel Reading

Mark 14:12-16, 22:26

Knowing that his life on earth was drawing to a close, Jesus gathered his closest friends to celebrate the Jewish Passover ritual meal, their final table fellowship as a small community. He knows that this will be his last opportunity to share through word and example the gift that will be offered. This gift is an unexpected surprise, the endless gift of his own self in the form of bread and wine. As Jesus is about to leave this earth in human form his followers are mandated to gather and share a simple memorial meal in his memory, thereby continuing to experience his presence in a unique way.
