Twenty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

The Deep End • All are Invited to the Banquet

In today's Gospel, Jesus uses the image of
a great banquet to explain God's vision
for our world. He speaks of a place where
those who consider themselves entitled
to the highest seats at the table take the
low seats. He urges us to invite the poor,
the lame and the blind to this
celebration. Jesus encourages us to turn
the world upside down in a reversal, an
upheaval, where the preferred option is
for the poor and those considered least
in society.

Today is an important day, as we begin
the Season of Creation (from 1
September until the Feast of St Francis on
4 October). Pope Francis asks all
Christians to embrace this season in
prayer, in living more sustainably and in
raising our voices in the public sphere.
We are invited to think more deeply
about what is happening at present to
the Earth, the environmental destruction

which now threatens our world, our
common home. The theme this year is
'The Web of Life.' The most vulnerable
among us are suffering most deeply as
this web of life begins to unravel. Our
faith calls us to respond to this crisis with
urgency. Let us hear the Gospel message
today, where we are called to consider
those on the margins, including those
most at risk from climate change, and let
us commit to working towards a world
where all are seated at the banquet.

Reflection for weekend 31st Aug & 1st Sept

We explore *Marriage*: Marriage is the meeting point where God unites the love of man and woman with his love. God comes with His divine love into the human love of the bridal couple. A Christian marriage is actually a covenant of 3 partners: the woman, the man and God. A couple that gets married in Church brings love itself on board with them. God goes through thick and thin with them. When two Christians marry, their union is additionally blessed with the dignity of a sacrament. When people think of a wedding, they think of flowers, music, dancing, beautiful clothes, good food and lots of friends and family. But the most important thing happens in Church: The moment when the two solemnly make their promise of marriage to one another before God. He blesses them and unites them with His love, so that they would have the strength to be faithful their whole life and to remain in love. Pope Francis: *"Living together is an art... It has 3 rules that can be summed up in 3 phrases: May I, Thank you and I'm sorry."* Finally a quote from Brother Roger Schutz, founder and prior of Taizé (1915-2005): *"In the evening of our life it will be love that we are judged on; the love that we have allowed slowly to grow and unfold."* **Brought to you by the Diocesan Pastoral Council**
