### Reflection for weekend of the 9th & 10th November 2019

The 5th Commandment: **You shall not kill.** No one person may take his or another person's life and potential for life. Each person is infinitely precious; I must not hate anybody, treat anybody in an unloving way or be endlessly resentful. Life is sacred. From the very beginning it belongs to God alone. When somebody is expecting a child, then God is happily expecting him or her too. The end of life is in God's hands. God is Lord over life and death. To deliberately take a person's life is murder. Murder is a serious sin.

"Put your sword back, for all who draw the sword will die by the sword," Jesus says to Peter in Mt 26:52. Peter wanted to fight Jesus's arrest with his sword. Finally a prayer. *Lord, God of peace, we thank you for all the longing, all the efforts, all the striving that your Spirit of peace kindles in our time. Open our spirits and our hearts still more to all our brothers and sisters who are now in need of love, so that, more and more, we may become bearers of peace. Amen.*

## Thirty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

### The Deep End • 'Children of the Resurrection'

In today's Gospel, the Sadducees are trying to trap Jesus, using a slightly exaggerated and absurd case about whose wife someone will be in heaven if they have married many times. They have no faith in the resurrection and therefore do not grasp that in a place of peace, justice and freedom, people cannot be 'owned' or 'given.' Questions like the one posed by the Sadducees ignore the radical freshness of the Kingdom of God. All we really can be sure of is that that place will be radically different to anything we know, a new creation.

We are all 'children of this world' who are called to be 'children of the resurrection.' You might recall today someone who has passed away, who is some sense, because of their influence on people, 'lives on' in the lives of those they touched. But they are 'children of

the resurrection' not because of their own goodness, but because of the power of Christ to raise us from the dead.

Let us use this week to notice the moments of resurrection all around us. God's Kingdom is also here and now, if we allow ourselves to be present and aware to this ongoing 'new creation'.

The purpose of the service is to provide an opportunity to remember as a community, people we love who have died - to reminisce and celebrate their lives and all they meant to us. This event is open to peoples of all faiths and of none. Tea and coffee will be served afterwards.

The Service is organised on an annual basis by the Standing Committee for End of Life Care at Wexford General Hospital. This committee is comprised of staff from all areas of the hospital. Their work includes organising the Service of Remembrance, implementing initiatives such as the writing and sending out of sympathy cards, refurbishment of the mortuary and family rooms, providing written bereavement information for relatives and developing education programmes for staff.
