Reflection for weekend of the 30th Nov & 1st Dec.

The 8th Commandment: You shall not bear false witness against your neighbour. God is the truth. He does not betray us and wants us to be honest with each other. Lying usually starts small – with a lame excuse or a little deception – and often ends up in a big mess. When you lie, nobody can trust you anymore. Lying is a poison that destroys every friendship. A quote from Warren Buffett (b.1930), an American investor: "If you tell the truth, you don't need to remember your lies". The 8th Commandment protects us from being betrayed and deceived. It also protects us from becoming false, dishonest people who nobody wants to have anything to do with. An honest person does not exaggerate. He doesn't make himself seem more important than he is. He doesn't condemn his neighbour and doesn't belittle others. He doesn't gossip. He doesn't spread falsehoods about others. One who follows God's 8th Commandment gains more and more courage to tell the truth, even if it's hard for him. Finally, a quote from Jesus: "I was born for this, I came into the world for this: to bear witness to the truth; and all who are on the side of truth listen to my voice" (Jn 18:37).
