### Notice From New Ross Municipal District

#### St Stephen's New Ross Lawn Cemetery

Please see below:

- A permit must be applied for before any monumental works are begun. The Monument company you will be using will do this for you
- The temporary placing of flowers on the grave is permitted for a period of one month following burial. Flowers will also be permitted on graves on Patron Day and can remain in place for the period of 21 days thereafter
- In the interests of amenity and management of this Lawn Cemetery, the following are **not permitted** to be placed on burial plots:
  - Grave "surrounds" or "kerbing" of any kind
  - Planting, including potted shrubbery and similar displays
  - Ornaments
  - Stone, shale, pebbles or any similar covering material
  - Pegs and similar markings

- The graves may be topped up from time to time by St Stephen's Cemetery Maintenance Team to remedy any subsidence

#### BRING YOUR MEDICATION LIST

A substantial amount of work is going on in the area of medication safety at Wexford General Hospital. However, there are many challenges around medication reconciliation and we would like to encourage patients themselves to play their role in reducing medication errors. As part of this we are encouraging all members of the public to carry a complete list of their medications at all times — preferably using the My Medicines List template. The HSE has launched a campaign called Know, Check, Ask and a tool for the public to help improve the safe use of medicines. It will help people who take medicines and everyone involved in their care to make better decisions about their treatment. The campaign aims to empower patients and encourages people who take regular medicines, and those assisting them, to know your medicines and keep a list, bringing it to appointments and if admitted to hospital, check that you are using the right medicine the right way. Ask your healthcare professional if you're unsure. The HSE tool is a 'My Medicines List' template which is available to download at [www.safermeds.ie](http://www.safermeds.ie)
