

#### **BUILDING THE NEW PARISH CHURCH**

Taken from Louis Cullen's Article "Building the new Parish Church"



The Church of St Mary and St Michaels in New Ross, Co. Wexford, was complete in 1902, and worship first took place in it on 28<sup>th</sup> September of that year. The last major church to be erected in Ferns, it is also the

diocese's largest. Its completion marked the end of a process of sustained church building, beginning in the 1820s, which peaked in the 1840s and 1850s. The erection of the Pugin-designed church in Gorey had begun as early as 1839; the cathedral in Enniscorthy was in



the 1840s, and the splendid twin churched of Wexford town were completed in the 1850s. Erected in tandem with the convent orders of nuns. Thus after mid-century three of the county's four major towns had churches which were not only architecturally distinguished but also fully adequate to the congregations' needs. New Ross by Contrast, its parish church having been raised almost half a century previously, had no church which could be compared stylistically with these structures, and which could hold as high a proportion of the community. The desirability of a

larger church for New Ross, one comparable with those of its sister towns, became a refrain of the diocese's bishops from mid-century. From this time every parish priest had at least to entertain the thought of enlarging the church, or erecting a new one, but to little effect for more than forty years.
