

Christmas Confessions

"I CONFESS TO....."

CHRISTMAS CONFESSION has been always an important element in the religious practice of Catholics - more especially nowadays in the lives of the older generations.

Like all other aspects of life, Covid 19 has stepped in disrupt that

For many years the Parish has catered for Christmas Confessions in two ways:- a Penitential Service during Christmas Week and Individual Confessions on Christmas Eve.

NEITHER OF THESE METHODS CAN BE OFFERED THIS YEAR.

There has always been provision in our Church for a third method of confessing sins in times of emergency - through GENERAL ABSOLUTION .The request has been made to allow that method this year in view of the present virus. The reply has been that PANDEMICS do not qualify, so General Absolution is not an option.

Therefore we are not in a position to offer any form of organised public gatherings for Confessions this Christmas.

However, we will, as always, be available for individual Confession on request.

In the absence of Confession and in an emergency, it has always been the teaching of the Church that an ACT OF CONTRITION suffices on condition that Confession will be sought as soon as possible afterwards. The sadness at failure and the strong intention to change have always been the essential and basic requirements for any form of Confession.

Confession was never intended to be - nor should it ever be a judgemental experience or a sentencing hearing. It is the occasion of returning to the God who loves, accepts and forgives. It is a celebration of His receiving us back and giving us the help to stay close to Him in the future.

If you decide to use the ACT OF CONTRITION method, I suggest that you do so in the context of the story of the **PRODIGAL SON** (Chapter 15 St. Luke's Gospel) as follows:-

- 1. Find a quiet spot.
- 2. Read the story, picturing the scene, the characters and hear the conversations.
- 3. Place **YOURSELF** in the story as the son (daughter) returning home.
- 4. Tell your story to God in front of you.
- 5. Listen to what He has to say. Expect to be amazed for our God is truly amazing.
- 6. Be in no hurry to leave His Presence.
