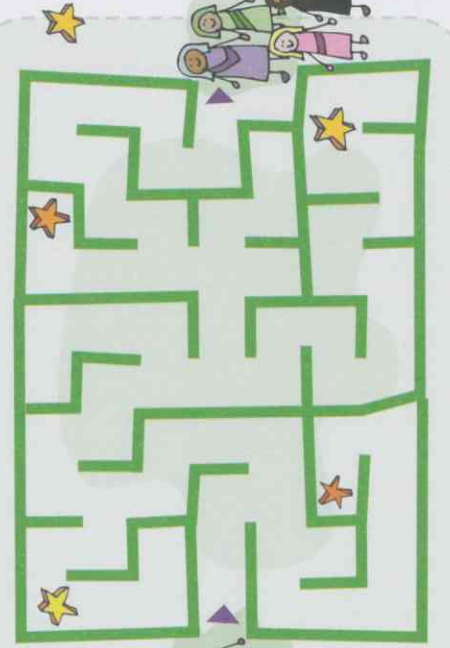

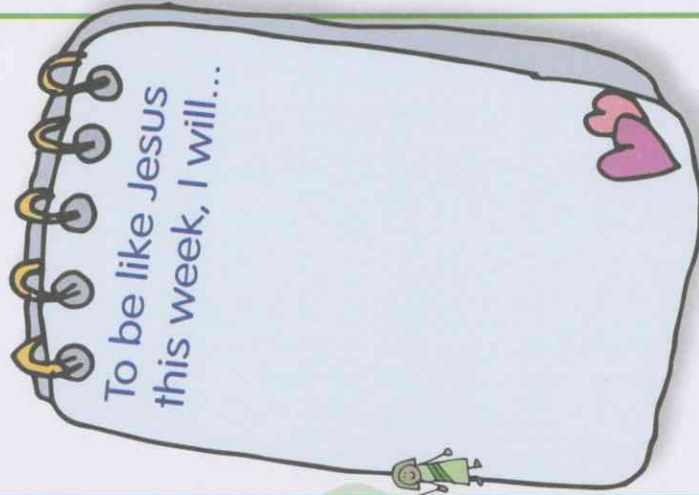
## Go, make disciples
