



CONGREGATION OF THE SISTERS OF MERCY

THE STORY OF THE SISTERS OF MERCY IN NEW ROSS

(Extract from Patrick Donovan's publication on the Centenary of the Christian Brothers in New Ross 1849 - 1949)

In 1853 the Parish Priest of Ross, Father James Walshe, invited Sisters of Mercy from the Convent of Mercy, Wexford, to found a Convent in Ross. This invitation was accepted, and on November 21st of the same year, the Convent was established. The Sisters of Mercy first resided in Priory St., in a house too small for educational activities, but while there they devoted themselves to charitable works, the relief of the necessitous, and the instruction of those who needed it.

After three years, in 1856, the Sisters were granted possession as tenants of the Tottenham town house, whither they removed. In this house they opened a select school for the benefit of children of the better class; and shortly afterwards they erected an adjacent 'Poor School,' i.e., a free school. The latter was connected with the National System of Education, as indicated by the following note supplied to me by the Dept of Education: 'The Mercy Convent School was taken into connection on 1st September, 1862, under the name of New Ross Female (No. 2) National School, Roll No. 9047, the teachers being described in the records as 'The Nuns.'

The Sisters continued to teach on the original site in South St. for almost forty years. Then, owing to pressure of increasing numbers, an important addition, St. Joseph's National School, was erected at the high eastern extremity of what had been once the Tottenhams' garden. These fine schools, built by that great Ross builder, Mr Andrew Cullen, under the Managership of Canon Kavanagh, were opened on April 13th, 1895, with girls on the upper

These schools also in course of time became overcrowded. In recent years the site of the old Cavalry Barracks, immediately to the east, was acquired. On this site, which at an early time had been occupied by St. Michael's Church of the old Norman town, the foundation stone of large National Schools to be conducted by the Sisters was laid on July 11th, 1943. These spacious schools were opened on April 22nd, 1945, following which St. Joseph's National Schools were converted into secondary schools.

In 1900 an Industrial School, conducted by the Sisters, was opened in the South St. part of

the rear of St. Joseph's National Schools. This building was put up by Thompson Brothers, Wexford, the cost being defrayed by Convent funds supplemented by a Government grant.


