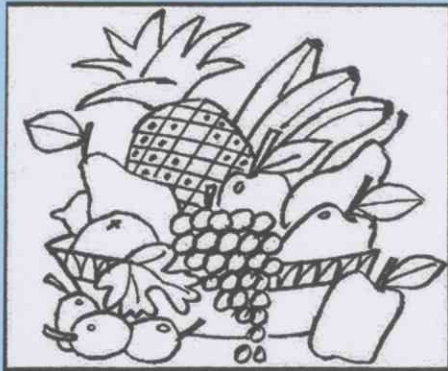




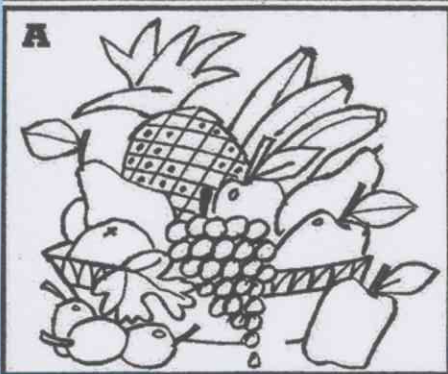

We call the good things we do "fruit". Find the good fruit in the wordsearch.

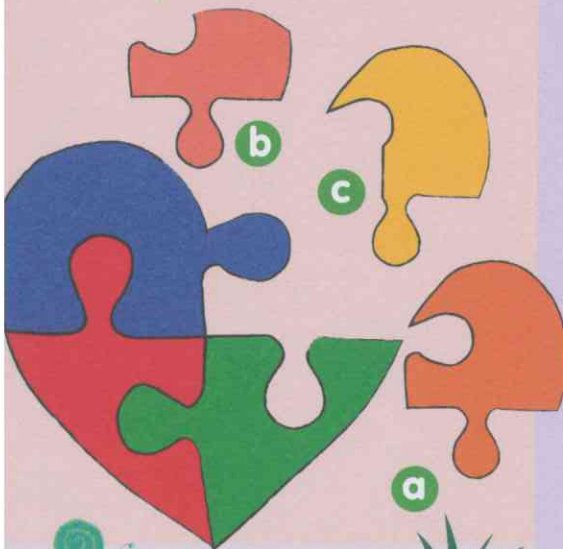
The words can go in any direction and letters might be used more than once!

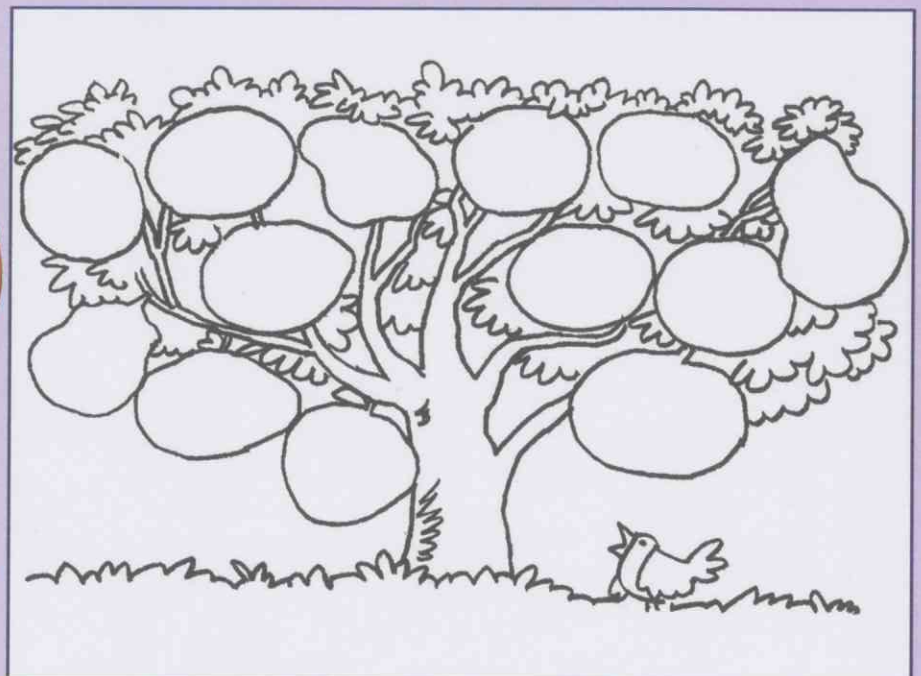


A PRAYER TO SAY
