Spot the difference

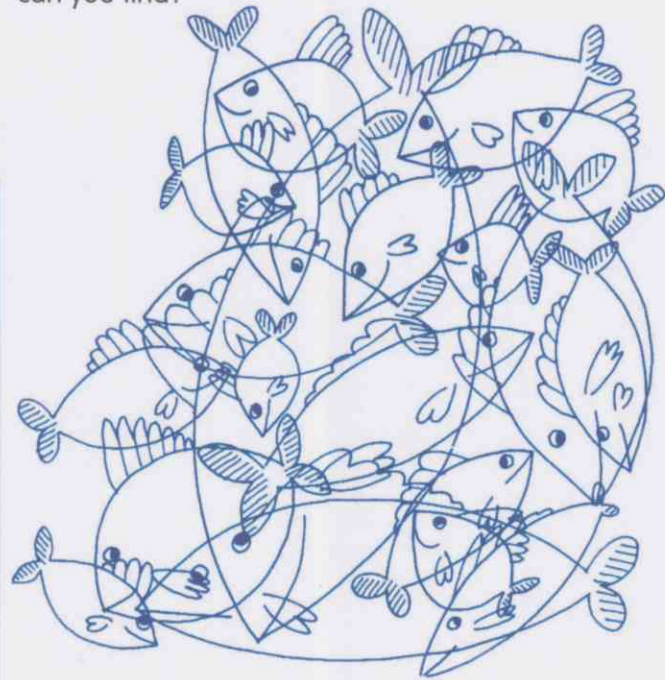
Jesus chose the fishermen to become apostles. An apostle is a messenger for God. How many differences can you find?
