



History Notes - Part 68 EASTER WATER DUTIES

A regular tasks of my Mass-serving duties long ago was arranging the procurement and supply of water for blessing as Easter Water. My server colleagues and myself were tasked with collecting galvanised baths on loan from designated house-holds in the Robert Street/Little Hill area. These handy sized baths (used for washing clothes – and children) were filled at the pump at the top of the street and carried to the church and stored in what was then the baptismal area (now the Billy Woods memorial room). The bath contents were in due course blessed as Easter Water and were available to the public who came with their jugs and bottles to secure a new supply of Easter Water. Easter Water was prized in those days as a comfort to the sick and as goodluck and a blessing to be sprinkled on crops and livestock. It was stored and treasured throughout the year in homes in the parish. When all parishioner's needs for Easter Water were fulfilled, the galvanised bath squad had the task of retuning the vessels to their owners, making sure that the right household received the right bath, with a thank you and **Courtesy of Jim Sutton** see you next year.
