Who is being honest?

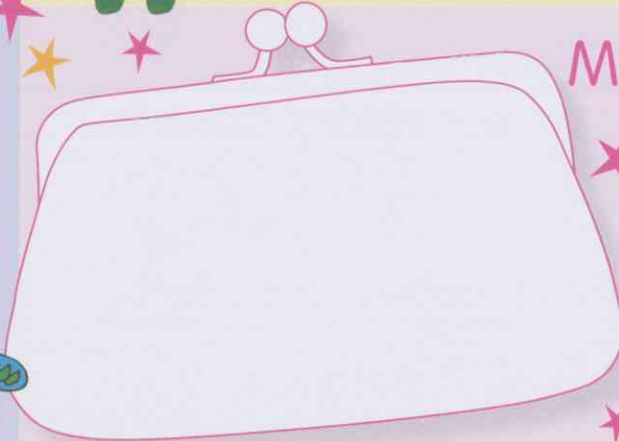


Put a circle around the children who are doing the right thing.
