



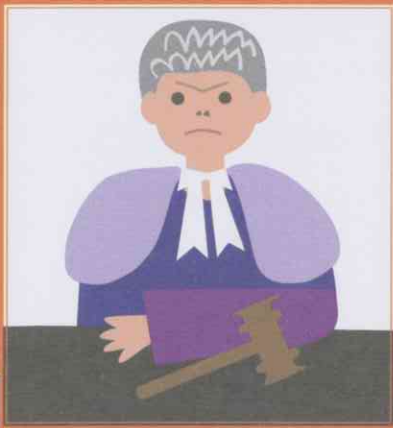

There are **five** differences between these two judges. Can you find them and draw rings round each one?



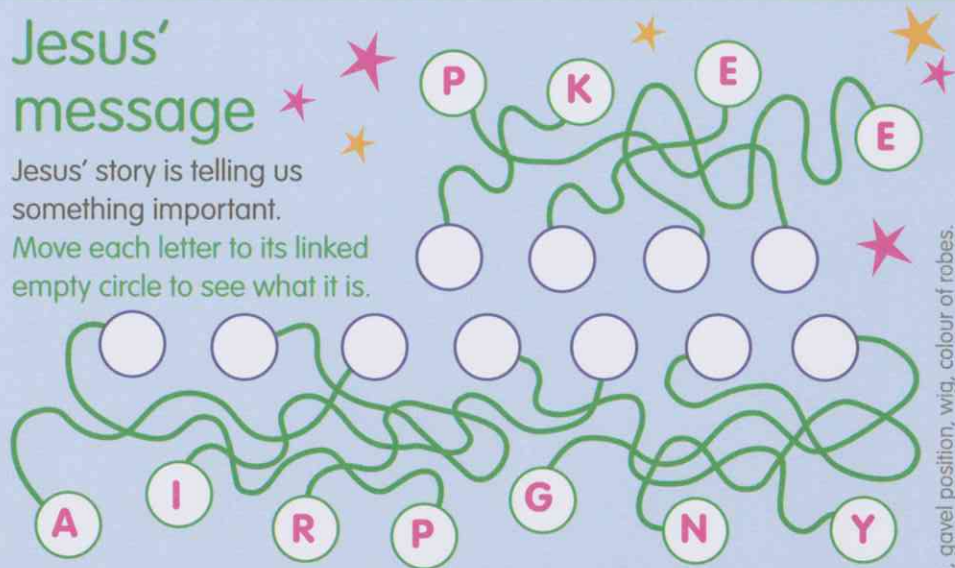
## A PRAYER TO SAY

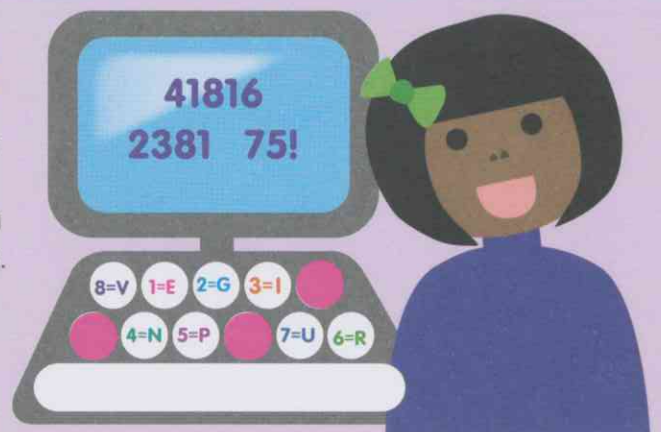
### Jesus' message

Jesus' story is telling us something important. Move each letter to its linked empty circle to see what it is.



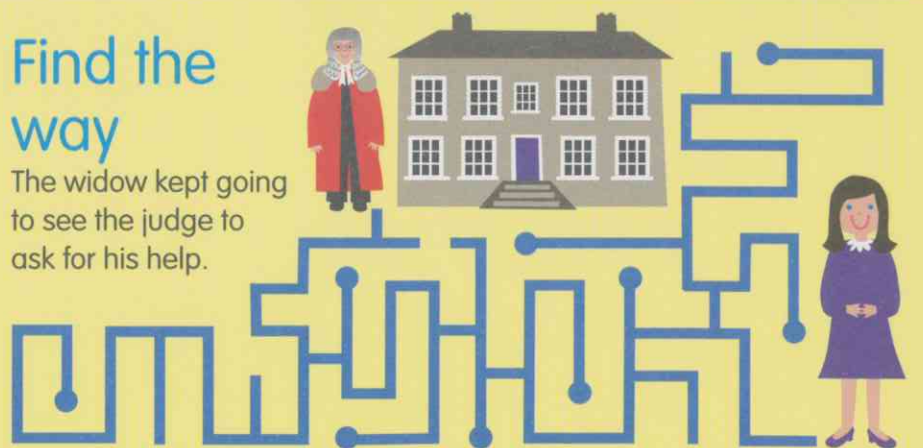
### Keywords
